- The admission process for acceptance to the MSN program:

  - A \$50 nonrefundable application fee
  - Copies of Current:
    - ✦ unrestricted RN License
  - Letter of intent (two page personal essay)
  - Resume showing recent nursing experience(s)
  - Minimum of two professional recommendation
  - All Official College Transcripts
